I. ELIGIBILITY

Any rising second or third-year student actively engaged in the College of Arts and Sciences at the University of Virginia is eligible to apply to be a J. Sanford Miller Family Arts Scholar. Each year, the faculty board admits up to four scholars in each of the four disciplines: dance, drama, music, and studio art. Artists who do not strictly belong to one discipline, such as writers and filmmakers, have also been welcomed into the program. Applicants should display involvement in the arts and excellence in courses specific to their disciplines, with a recommended GPA of 3.400 or higher in all arts courses and a cumulative GPA of 3.200 or higher.
