## UVA Summer Chamber Music Festival

Join the UVA faculty this summer in an intensive five-day chamber music festival. The focus will be on developing musicianship skills which go “beyond the notes” - the listening, rhythmic, analytical, and diplomatic skills that go into the making of quality chamber music. Students will study appropriately assigned repertoire in detail with faculty members in small ensembles and orchestra, culminating with a final performance in Old Cabell Hall.

The program will meet on the grounds of the University of Virginia from 9:00am - 5:00pm, Tuesday, June 26 through Friday, June 29, and on Saturday, June 30 from 11:00am through 1:00 pm. Students will perform in a final concert the afternoon of June 30. Each day will be divided into chamber ensemble coachings and rehearsals, master classes, and large chamber ensemble rehearsals. There is a non-refundable application fee of \$30, and the program fee is \$320 (\$370 if received after May 15).

The workshop is open to college and high school students, advanced middle school students, and adult amateur musicians who play string, woodwind, brass, and percussion instruments. Applicants should have a minimum of three years of individual instrumental study and one year of ensemble experience. Teacher recommendation and an audition CD or DVD are required.

The program fee includes coaching/instruction, lunch, and snacks each day, locker rental for the week, and two tickets to the 2013 UVA Chamber Music Festival. Parking is available for an additional fee.

### Application Materials

Each application must include a completed application form, the application fee, and a CD or DVD recording. Recording requirements are described in detail on the application form. Only complete applications will be evaluated for admission.

### Parking

Parking is available for participants at an additional cost in adjacent lots on grounds. Parking information will be provided to festival participants upon request.

### Lockers

Each student will receive a locker in Old Cabell Hall to store his or her instrument and materials during the week of the festival.

### Lunch and Snacks

Lunch and snacks will be provided each day to participants. Juice and sodas are also provided. We will make every effort to accommodate special dietary needs if necessary and specified at least one week prior to the beginning of the festival. Please direct such special requests to the director via email. In an effort to have limited negative impact on the environment, bottled water will not be provided. There are water fountains in Old Cabell Hall, and festival participants are encouraged to bring their own bottled water from home.

### Chamber Ensembles

Faculty members coach each group at arranged times, alternating with scheduled rehearsals in which each group works independently in a focused and productive fashion. Goals will be set for these sessions with the guidance of the coaches.

Students will be placed into ensembles according to their placement from the application recording. Groups will be formed as appropriate to their experience level and instrumentation. Music will cover the main staples of the chamber music repertoire for each instrument family as well as mixed instrumentation.

### Master Classes

Each day there will be both large and small group master classes. Some will be geared toward individual instruments or instrument families, while others will cover much broader topics related to the interpretation and performance of music.

### Performance

All participants are invited to perform. If a particular group does not feel 'ready' to perform, special arrangements will be made with the help of the coaches so that the students' performances are a success.

### Concert & Reception

The Festival concert will take place at 3:00 pm on Saturday, June 30, 2012. A reception in the lobby of Old Cabell Hall will follow the performance.

### Housing/Host Families

Host families are provided for students who do not live in the Charlottesville area. Host families provide their guests breakfast and dinner each day, rides to and from the festival as necessary, and sleeping accommodations. Arrival and departure schedules will be set with individual participants and host families. The Director matches hosts and students. If you need housing in order to attend the festival, or if you would like to serve as a host family, please indicate this on your application form. Every effort will be made to find hosts for adult students who do not live in the Charlottesville area, but cannot be guaranteed.
