### Requirements for the Minor in Religious Studies:

The minor program in Religious Studies requires the completion of a minimum of five graded courses (15 credits) within the Department of Religious Studies. Two courses must be taken in one of the world's major religious traditions as a primary concentration: African religions (RELA), Buddhism (RELB), Christianity (RELC), Hinduism (RELH), Islam (RELI) or Judaism (RELJ). RELG 1010 may be counted toward a concentration in Christianity, Islam or Judaism. RELG 1040 may be counted toward a concentration in Buddhism or Hinduism. At least one of the five required courses (3 credits) must be taken at the 3000 level, or above.
